



## **Logo Contest Submission Guidelines for the ERASMUS+ project titled: Past, Present and Future – It's All in the Sky**

### § 1 Overview

1. The purpose of this Logo Contest is to design a logo for the ERASMUS Plus project titled: Past, Present and Future – It's All in the Sky which is subsidized by the European Union within Erasmus+ program. The project will be implemented in five institutions:

- Osnovna škola Josip Pupačić (Croatia)
- 12th Primary School of Drama (Greece)
- ISTITUTO COMPRENSIVO S. BAGOLINO (Italy)
- Szkoła Podstawowa nr 5 im. UNICEF w Koszalinie (Poland)
- Scoala Gimnaziala nr 7 Buzau (Romania)

2. The logo will be used online, in print, on banners and on gadgets like T-shirts or folders, etc.

3. The final version of the logo will need to be suitable for high quality printing in large formats as well as in relatively small sizes on the headers of documents.

4. The Contest is organised by the Project Coordinators from the participating schools hereafter referred to as the Organisers.

### § 2 Copyrighted Matter

Entrants should take care to ensure that their Entries are not in any way similar to existing logos or other copyrighted images. Please respect copyrights of other artists and make your own design, based on the idea that inspired you.

### § 3 Required Elements

1. The logo should make reference to the topic of the project and/or the countries participating in the project.

2. Although it is not obligatory, the logo could make reference to the European Union.



3. The logo must not contain any abusive text or imagery.

#### § 4 Graphic Format

1. Submissions can be hand drawn or prepared digitally.
2. High resolution files are required – the acceptable image file formats are .PNG, .JPG, .JPEG.
3. The hand drawn works have to be presented in A4 and the dimension of the logo will be the maximum 15x15 cm, which does not imply that it should be a square shape.

#### § 5 Deadline for Entries

1. The logo design and completed entry form must be submitted by 11:00 GMT, Tuesday, 1st December 2020.
2. They must be submitted to the person responsible for the competition in each of the participating countries (please contact them for more details). The entries in Poland must be submitted to Ms Jolanta Mikołajczak

#### § 6 Judging will be carried out according to the following criteria:

1. Originality of the design.
2. Clarity of message related to the Project and/or the ERASMUS plus program.
3. Visual impact.
4. Reproducibility (on website and documents).
5. The competition Organizers reserve the right to disqualify any entry at their sole discretion.

#### § 7 Selection of Winners

1. All entries will be screened, those that comply with the official contest rules and have met the guidelines and specifications will be judged.
2. The Organisers will select up to three entries from each participating country and place them on an internet voting platform without any information about the authors.



3. Voting will take place between the 10th and the 20th of December 2020.
4. If there is no winner, the Organisers will select the winner.
5. The results of the competition will be announced on the participating schools' websites within a week and the winner will be notified.
6. The decision of the Organisers will be final.

#### § 8 Intellectual Property Rights

1. Any and all intellectual property or other related rights in the logos submitted in this competition will belong to the ERASMUS Plus project titled: Past, Present and Future – It's All in the Sky and shall be its sole exclusive property.
2. The Organisers reserve the right to use the logo in any manner that they sees fit.

#### § 9 Agreement to Official Rules

1. By participating in the competition, participants agree to abide by the rules and conditions as established above.

#### § 10 Final Remarks

1. In the event of inconsistency or discrepancy between the English version and any of the other linguistic versions of this document, the English language version shall prevail
